If you are fortunate enough to be allocated one of our Gold Bond places, you will be required to raise a minimum of **£2,020 sponsorship** (exclusive of match funding and Gift Aid). By accepting the place, you are pledging and committing to raising this sponsorship amount. The Events Team will provide you with advice and support on how to meet this goal. Ideas include match funding, sponsorship and fundraising events. It's important that you think about how you will reach this target and the training commitment involved before applying for a place.

Those who are successful will become honorary members of #TeamSFH20. We love our runners and think they are all heroes! That's why we've created #TeamSFH20.
